In re: Application of **CARNEGIE NATURAL GAS COMPANY** for the approval of the construction of one 36 inch steel pipe under and across the right of way and tracks of The Pennsylvania Railroad Company at a point 1083 feet north of the center of the station of said railroad company in the borough of Duquesne.

REPORT AND ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

This case being before the Commission upon petition of the **CARNEGIE NATURAL GAS COMPANY**, dated March 7th, 1918, for the approval of the construction of one 36 inch steel pipe under and across the right of way and tracks of The Pennsylvania Railroad Company, at a point 1083 feet north of the center of the station of said railroad company in the borough of Duquesne; in accordance with the provisions of an agreement between the said railroad company and said gas company dated February 23rd, 1918, which agreement is this day approved by this Commission (Application 1829-1918); and having been duly heard and submitted by the parties, and due investigation of the matters and things involved having been had, the Commission finds and determines that the granting of said petition is necessary and proper for the service, accommodation, convenience and safety of the public, and that a Certificate of Public Convenience be issued evidencing the Commission's approval thereof:

NOW, to-wit, April 8th, 1918, IT IS ORDERED:
That a Certificate of Public Convenience be issued evidencing the Commission's approval of the construction of said utility crossing as above set forth.
