A. 1829 and 1830-1918-Application of the Carnegie Natural Gas Company for the approval of an agreement between said company and the Pennsylvania Railroad Company whereby the railroad company grants the gas company the right to construct under its right of way cen 36 inch cast iron steel pipe at a location 1083 feet north of the center of the railroad station in the borough of Duquesne, and one concrete station in the borough of Duquesne, and one concrete station in the borough of Duquesne and one concrete culvert over Thompson's Run in said borough, and for the approval of the construction of said pipe line and culbert. Memorandum report was submitted, recommending that the applications be approved. A. 1839-1918-Application of the Pennsylvania Railroad Company and the Susquehanna, Bloomsburg and Berwick Railroad Company for the approval of the acquisition by the former of the franchises, corporate property, rights, and credits of the latter company. Memorandum report was submitted recommending that the application be approved. On motion the application was approved and the certificate of public convenience evidencing the Commission's approval was directed to be issued.
