Application of BUCKEYE PIPE LINE COMPANY, an Ohio corporation, for approval of the right to begin to offer, render, furnish or supply service to the public by pipeline in the transportation of petroleum and petroleum products, said pipeline generally paralleling an existing pipeline of said company near Macungie, Lehigh County, northwardly to the Pennsylvania-New York boundary line at a point south of Binghamton, New York, and having a connection to its delivery terminal near Dupont, Luzerne County.

REPORT AND ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter being before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission upon application of BUCKEYE PIPE LINE COMPANY, an Ohio corporation, filed February 21, 1967, for approval of the right to begin to offer, render, furnish or supply service to the public by pipeline in the transportation of petroleum and petroleum products, said pipeline generally paralleling an existing pipeline of said company near Macungie, Lehigh County, northwardly to the Pennsylvania-New York boundary line at a point south of Binghamton, New York, and having a connection to its delivery terminal near Dupont, Luzerne County, and having been duly presented in accordance with the rules of the Commission, and full investigation of the matters and things involved having been had, the Commission finds and determines that the granting of said application is necessary or proper for the service, accommodation, convenience or safety of the public, and that a certificate of public convenience issue evidencing the Commission's approval thereof;

NOW, to wit, April 24, 1967, IT IS ORDERED: That a certificate of public convenience issue evidencing the Commission's approval of the said application, as above determined.
