ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION, JANUARY 8, 1962:

The matters and things involved in this application having been duly submitted, and full consideration having been given thereto, we find and determine that it is necessary or proper for the service, accommodation, convenience, or safety of the public that a certificate of public convenience issue evidencing approval thereof; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That the beginning by The Buckeye Pipe Line Company, a corporation of the State of Ohio, of the exercise of the right, power, or privilege of transporting, storing, and distributing petroleum products by means of pipelines and appurtenances, for the public, such facilities extending eastwardly from a point in the Borough of Midland, Beaver County, to a point on the south side of the Allegheny River, in the City of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, be and is hereby approved, and that a certificate of public convenience issue at A. 88470, Folder 2, evidencing such approval.
