Your Honor:

An order regarding Reply Briefs was issued on April 29, 2020 (original briefs dated January 30, 2020). Cindy Kelly respectfully requests that the time to file the Reply Brief in the above matter, which is currently set to be due on May 28, 2020, be extended until at least September 1st 2020.

You are probably aware that a global pandemic was declared in March 2020. PA has consistently been in the top 6 states with regard to numbers of cases. Lehigh county where I live is also one of the hardest hit counties in the state and we are still under stay at home orders. I understand that not all counties have been equally affected, so I will describe what this means to us.

Every facet of our lives has been upended. My husband and I are both in the high-risk category. There have been a variety of social, household, health and economic impacts to navigate, requiring excessive amounts of time compared to pre-March 2020. Every normal function to manage our household now takes 4-6 times longer, to find places we can get food, household and medical supplies we need to live. We need to navigate shortages, restrictions and a variety of suppliers. Additionally, I need to find others for delivery, pickup or shopping for our needs. We also have had to find people willing and able to make household repairs at this time. Then there has been the need to navigate systems for loans, unemployment assistance, and finding new insurance carriers due to employment changes.

The social and mental impact has been equally challenging, not to mention my own health issues which you are aware. Making sure that family, friends and community members are ok during this time and have what they need has also taken a lot of effort and time, as well as energy. Then there is the emotional grief as this virus takes the lives of some of the people we care about.

I am requesting an additional 3 months to prepare a reply brief. This time is needed due to the added stress of the continued impact of the global pandemic on our lives and the additional time needed to refresh the details on the original brief which was 4 months ago. The transcript alone is 390 pages long and several pieces of evidence were admitted just over 10 days ago. While the pandemic will not be over in 3 months, the additional time will

allow me to meet current responsibilities, not put my life in danger due to the added stress, and assemble a proper reply brief and the amount of detail required.
