

**MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION OF GROUNDS FOR  
NOT INCLUDING COMPLAINANT IN PROCESS**

Comes now Complainant Dr. Deborah A. Redman and moves the Commission for clarification as to why Complainant Redman is not being included in the complaint process. The process broke down this spring. Although Dr. Redman filed a Notice of Inability to Attend May 2020 Hearing and Repeat Request to Transfer Matter to Neutral Group on May 14, Dr. Redman assumes that an *ex parte* hearing was held on May 21 between Judge Long and FirstEnergy/Penelec counsel Morris. She received a 19 May e-mail from ALJ Mary Long warning “that a failure to appear may result in the dismissal of the complaint” despite the fact that Dr. Redman had filed multiple documents explaining that she could not participate because she has been life-threateningly ill from being subjected to sewage on a daily basis by the power companies. Even if the case was dismissed, Redman should receive a paper copy with e-mailed back-up. And although on

13 May Dr. Redman filed a Notice that she had not received a Prehearing Order for a May hearing (either by mail or e-mail) and asked for a mailed copy, she received nothing.

**Because Administrative Law Judge Long has ceased communication with Dr. Redman, she requests that *Chief Judge Rainey* respond to this motion.**
