In accordance with the Interim Order issued on February 21, 2020 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of West Penn Power Company ("West Penn"). Mr. and Mrs. Altman were directed to provide full and complete responses to the Company's discovery requests as well as submit notification of their anticipated witnesses on or before March 13, 2020. As of the submission of this status report, West Penn has not received responses to its discovery requests nor notification of Mr. and Mrs. Altman's anticipated witnesses.

Given the lack of response, West Penn hereby renews its Motion to Dismiss which was filed on November 20, 2020 and seeks to dismiss the formal complaint of Mr. and Mrs. Altman for their failure to abide by the various interim orders issued in this proceeding. Alternatively, it may be valuable for a prehearing conference to be set for this matter in order to determine Mr. and Mrs. Altman's intent in moving their complaint forward.
