Request for Extension of Time, Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(a)(1), to Hold a Semi-Annual Meeting with Customers

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(a)(1), Hidden Valley Utility Services, L.P. ("HVUS") files this Letter-Petition requesting an extension of time for holding a semi-annual customer meeting, as required by Ordering Paragraph 5.b of the Order entered in this matter on January 18, 2018. That Ordering Paragraph requires HVUS to hold a semi-annual customer meeting by June 30, 2020. For the reasons set forth below, HVUS respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days to hold the initial customer meeting for 2020. HVUS will hold a second customer meeting later in the year.

Section 1.15(a)(1) provides:

Except as otherwise provided by statute, whenever under this title or by order of the Commission, or notice given thereunder, an act is required or allowed to be done at or within a specified time, the time fixed or the period of time prescribed may, by the Commission, the presiding officer or other authorized person, for good cause be extended upon motion made before expiration of the period originally prescribed or as previously extended.

HVUS has good cause for the requested extension. HVUS has been unable to secure a site near Hidden Valley that would permit an in-person meeting with customers while maintaining social distancing and other mitigation measures required during the COVID-19 Pandemic. HVUS needs additional time to explore means of holding a virtual meeting with a large number of customers.

HVUS has shared this extension request with the other Parties to this proceeding. The Office of Consumer Advocate and Mr. Robert J. Kollar indicated that they do not oppose the request. To date, no response has been received from the other Parties to this proceeding.
