BY THE COMMISSION:

By application docketed November 19, 1984, Fischer-Hughes Transport, Inc., a corporation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, seeks approval of the transfer to it of all the rights granted to Robert M. Hughes, t/d/b/a Hughes Moving and Storage, under the certificate issued at A-00100491.

We find the applicant to be fit to hold a certificate of public convenience and that approval of the application is necessary and proper for the continuation of service to the public; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That the application for the transfer of rights held by Robert M. Hughes, t/d/b/a Hughes Moving and Storage, at A-00100491, be approved and that a certificate be issued to the applicant granting the following rights:

1. To transport, as a Class D carrier, aircraft, household goods, personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the furnishings, equipment, or supplies of such dwelling as an incidental part of a removal by the householder from one domicile to another; furniture, fixtures, equipment and the property of stores, offices, museums, institutions, hospitals or other establishments when a part of the stock, equipment or supply of such stores, offices, museums, institutions, hospitals or other establishments, in connection with a removal from one location to another; and articles in use, including objects of art, displays and exhibits

which, because of their unusual nature or value, require specialized handling and equipment usually employed in moving household goods, between points in the counties of Philadelphia, Delaware, Chester, Montgomery and Bucks, included within a line which connects the municipal boundaries of Chester, West Chester, Paoli, Norristown, Doylestown and Morrisville, but not including said places.

2. To transport, as a Class D carrier, aircraft, household goods, personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the furnishings, equipment, or supplies of such dwelling as an incidental part of a removal by the householder from one domicile to another; furniture, fixtures, equipment and the property of stores, offices, museums, institutions, hospitals or other establishments when a part of the stock, equipment or supply of such stores, offices, museums, institutions, hospitals or other establishments, in connection with a removal from one location to another; and articles in use, including objects of art, displays and exhibits which, because of their unusual nature or value, require specialized handling and equipment usually employed in moving household goods, from points in the counties of Philadelphia, Delaware, Chester, Montgomery and Bucks, included within a line which connects the municipal boundaries of Chester, West Chester, Paoli, Norristown, Doylestown and Morrisville, but not including said places, to other points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa;

subject to the following conditions:

1. That the approval hereby given is not to be understood as committing the Commission, in any proceedings that may be brought before it for any purpose, to fix a valuation on the property and rights to be acquired by applicant from the present certificate holder equal to the consideration to be paid therefor, or equal to any value that may be placed thereon by applicant, or to approve or prescribe rates sufficient to yield a return thereon.
2. That applicant shall not record in its utility accounts any amount representing the rights herein granted, in excess of the actual cost of such rights to the original holder thereof.

3. That the applicant charge to Account 1550, Other Intangible Property, \$16,000, being the amount of the consideration payable by it for the rights and going concern value attributable thereto; less any amount recorded under condition 2 above.
4. That the operating authority granted herein, or now held or subsequently granted to the applicant to the extent that it is duplicative shall not be construed as conferring more than one operating right.
5. That the certificate holder shall comply with all of the provisions of the Public Utility Law as now existing or as may hereafter be amended, and Pa. Code Title 52, Chapter 31, as now existing or as may hereafter be amended, and any other rules and regulations as may hereafter be prescribed by the Commission. Failure to comply shall be sufficient cause to suspend, revoke or rescind the rights and privileges conferred by the certificate.
6. That the certificate holder shall not transfer, sell or in any way convey any of its outstanding capital stock to any individual, partnership, corporation or any entity, without the prior filing of an application and approval thereof by the Commission under Section 1102(3) of Title 66, PA C.S.A.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the applicant shall not engage in any transportation granted herein until it has complied with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Law and the rules and regulations of this Commission relative to the filing and acceptance of evidence of insurance and a tariff establishing just and reasonable rates.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That issuance of the certificate shall be withheld pending submission of transferor's Annual Report for the year 1984, and any accompanying fine.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That in the event said applicant has not, on or before sixty (60) days from the date of the service of this order, complied with the requirements hereinbefore set forth, the application shall be dismissed without further proceedings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That upon compliance with this order the rights granted the transferor, Robert M. Hughes, t/d/b/a Hughes Moving and Storage, at A-00100491 be cancelled and the record be marked closed.

Dear Mr. Kahn:

Under date of June 12, 1985, the Secretary's office transmitted to you the Commission's compliance order of June 7, 1985, evidencing approval of the above carrier's application at A-103976, Folder 1, Am-A, which is in effect a transfer of the rights formerly held by Robert M. Hughes, t/d/b/a Hughes Moving and Storage at A-103976, Folder 1, Am-A. The letter transmitting the order directs attention to the requirement for the filing of a tariff.

In accordance with the provisions of Pa. Code, Title 52, Section 23.13(c), you should immediately arrange to file adoption supplements with us whereby, the tariff of the former operator will become the tariff of the latter, and no change in rates is permitted to cover the transfer of rights. To assist you in meeting this tariff requirement, we are enclosing three copies of the necessary supplement to be properly executed by the carriers, the original and one copy of which must be returned to us for filing and the remaining copy to be retained for the carrier's records.

We also notice that rates for a part of the authorized service of Robert M. Hughes, t/d/b/a Hughes Moving and Storage are provided in tariffs published by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc. Our records indicate that the transferree now participates in the publications of Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc. under previously-certificated rights and it is, therefore necessary to issue a revocation notice, in duplicate, for the transferor's power of attorney, and to arrange for the cancellation of the transferor's participation from the agency publication.
