

O R D E R

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 12, 1982, Fischer-Hughes Transport, Inc. (Petitioner) filed an application seeking approval of the transfer to it of all the rights granted to Fischer's Transfer, Inc. under the certificate issued at A-00097286. By an order adopted on June 18, 1982 (entered June 29, 1982) the Commission granted the application on the condition that the Petitioner comply with certain insurance filing requirements within sixty (60) days. On November 3, 1982, after warning letters had been sent, the Secretary of the Commission sent a letter to the Petitioner stating that the application was dismissed due to the Petitioner's failure to provide proof of insurance. On November 16, 1982, the Petitioner filed the instant Petition to Reinstate.

The Petitioner avers that it has had insurance policies in effect since March, 1982. The Petitioner indicates that it was in contact with its insurance company every time it received a warning notice from the Public Utility Commission and that each time, it was advised by the insurance company that the certificate of insurance had been filed with the Commission. On November 19, 1982 the certificate of insurance was received by the Commission.


It appears that the Petitioner made a good faith effort to comply with the Commission's insurance filing regulations, and now has complied with those regulations. Since the Petitioner has now satisfied the Commission's insurance requirements and was also prompt in seeking reconsideration, it appears that reinstatement would be appropriate.

It appears that the Petition to Reinstate has merit;
THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Petition to Reinstate is hereby granted.
2. That the dismissal of application A-00103976 by Commission letter on November 3, 1982, is hereby superseded.
3. That the said application, approved by the Commission on June 18, 1982, is hereby reinstated.
