Dear ALJ Johnson,

With all due respect, I do not understand how your June 30th order provides any accommodation as per what I agreed to with Met-Ed. I comprehended that I was to first prepare and submit WRITTEN testimony, and also have my witnesses produce WRITTEN testimony, and also receive from Met-Ed the written testimony of their witness. Only then would I have time to read and comprehend the material prior to any cross-examination. It is impossible for me with my condition to spontaneously cross-examine Met-Ed's expert witness with no knowledge of his testimony, and I do not know how they can cross examine my expert witnesses without their written testimony to which we recently agreed.

In your June 30th order you are asking me to present my testimony on July 14th, which is different from what we agreed to - that I would prepare it first in written form and Met-Ed would then, in written form, file their objections. I comprehended that I would also receive written testimony from Met-Ed and have the opportunity to file written objections so that I have the proper amount of time to read, comprehend and respond to the material. Only after these steps would a limited oral hearing for cross-examination of our expert witnesses make any sense.

I am requesting further clarification on how your June 30th Order provides me with any ADA accommodation or else am requesting an amended order to reflect more appropriately the written submission of testimony to which I agreed upon with Met-Ed which would entail continuing the July 14th hearing to a more appropriate date in the scheduling of this matter. Thank you for your review of my situation and consideration of my request.
