Pursuant to the interim Order Directing Litigation Schedule dated June 10, 2020, Metropolitan Edison Company (“Met-Ed” or the “Company”) hereby submits this status report. Met-Ed and the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”) have agreed to the following procedural schedule in this proceeding:

Met-Ed notes that it and I&E have further agreed to discuss and establish deadlines for the submission of Main Briefs and Reply Briefs at the conclusion of hearings in this matter.

In addition, Met-Ed and I&E have continued settlement discussions in this matter since the June 10, 2020 Prehearing Conference. On June 17, 2020, Met-Ed provided I&E with a settlement proposal with respect to remedial measures. On June 29, the parties held a telephonic settlement conference to discuss the remedial measures proposed by Met-Ed and their impact on the Company's position with respect to any financial penalty. Per I&E's request at that conference, Met-Ed provided additional information to I&E on June 30. At this time, the Company is awaiting further feedback on its proposal from I&E. It is the Company's view that the parties will continue working in earnest towards a resolution of this matter in total. Moreover, Met-Ed remains committed to continuing settlement negotiations during the course of this proceeding.
