**Motion for Extension of Briefing Schedule**

An evidentiary hearing in this proceeding was held on February 20, 2020. On May 29, 2020 we received Judge Watson's Interim Order to Establish a Briefing Schedule dated May 28, 2020, which set the due date for briefs to be submitted on or before July 10, 2020.

Due to Covid 19, PUC offices remaining closed, and our inability to view the transcript of our hearing, complainant requests an extension of the briefing schedule.

1. We simply cannot recall the details of the February hearing well enough to write an effective brief. To properly prepare the brief, we need to view a copy of the official transcript.
2. The PUC offices remain closed even now, so we have not had access to the PUC copy of the transcript.
3. Also due to the pandemic, I (Andrew) have been without work, and cannot afford to pay for my own copy of the transcript.
4. Consequently we cannot prepare our brief, which is necessary to our case, without access to the transcript. *We cannot access the transcript due to conditions beyond our control.*
5. If the PUC can make their copy of the transcript accessible to us via electronic means, we can prepare our brief. *In that case, we request an extension of sixty (60) days from the date of transcript access.*

6. If free, electronic access is not possible, we request a stay of all proceedings in this matter until such time as the PUC offices are open, and we can come to the offices to view the transcript. *We request at least sixty (60) days from the date access to the transcript becomes possible.*
