(b) On or about April 27, 1970, the Commission instituted an investigation into the safety of the subject bridge. On June 1, 1970, the Commission directed the Department of Highways to restore and repair the Thompson Run Bridge at its initial cost and expense. On December 2, 1983, the Department notified the Commission that the work has been completed. By letter received from the Department on February 13, 1990, the Department informed the Commission that all outstanding matters have been satisfied and the matter may be closed. Furthermore, verbal conversation with railroad personnel on March 1, 1990, revealed that they have no outstanding issues remaining.

(c) The Bureau of Safety and Compliance recommends that the case be closed. All work has been completed. It is also recommended that all parties of record be notified of the Commission's action by Secretarial letter.
