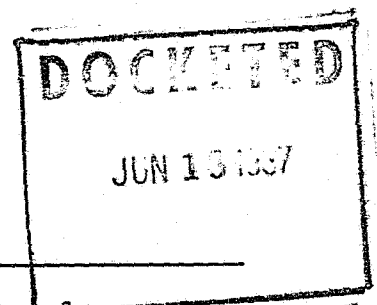

(a) Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission v. Department of Highways of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Union Railroad Company, City of Duquesne, County of Allegheny, The Bell Telephone Company of Pennsylvania, Carnegie Natural Gas Company, Duquesne Light Company, Equitable Gas Company, and Keystone Pipeline Company.

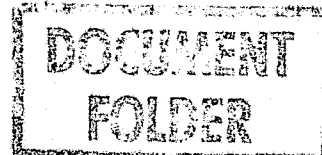
(b) By letter dated December 11, 1986, Duquesne Light Company requests certification of its bill, totalling \$72,670.52 for costs incurred by the company in furnishing material and performing work in this proceeding. By a Commission order entered July 29, 1986, Department of Transportation was directed to reimburse Duquesne Light Company 20% of said costs.

(c) The Bureau recommends: (1) the Commission approve Duquesne Light Company's bill, dated November 19, 1986, received December 15, 1986; (2) the Department of Transportation be authorized to pay Duquesne Light Company the sum of \$14,534.10 which is 20% of the actual costs; (3) the parties of interest be notified of the Commission's action by Secretarial letter, and a copy of same be placed in the Commission's document folder; and (4) the certified bill be forwarded to the Department of Transportation.



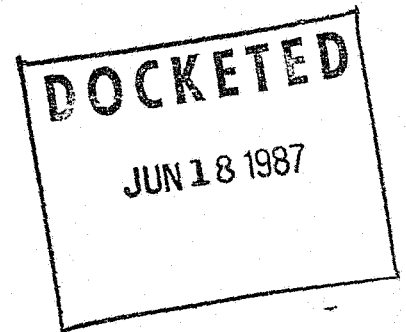

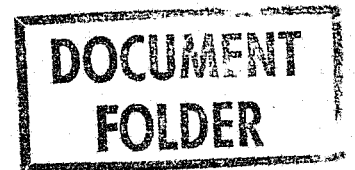
