d. BROKER PAYMENT STRUCTURE: If applicant is a broker/marketer, explain how your organization will be collecting your fees.

Applicant (broker/marketer) will be collecting fees directly from supplier(s) through the traditional means of fee payments. CCI Industries, Inc. will generate and collect its fees via an adder on the given suppliers base price. Essentially we shop the market for our customers through the various suppliers we work with and go with the lowest rate where we can add our adder and still be competitive for the customer. Fee will be calculated on a per deal basis as every deal and every territory has different rates.

The suppliers that applicant will be conducting business with will pay in these various forms:

Residual Fee Payments: Whereas the fee paid is the actual fee based on the prior month's energy consumption X the # of energy units X the fee applied to each energy unit.

Example: 100,000 kWh consumed in March X .003 (fee) = \$300.00 March Fee

Up-Front Fee Payments: Where the fee paid is an upfront payment based on an estimate of total units of energy consumption during the term of the customer's contract with supplier.

Example: 800,000 akWh consumed per year X 3 year agreement with supplier X .003 fee applied = \$7,200.00

Hybrid Fee Payments: Where supplier will pay fee's to broker in both the up-front and residual fashion.

Example: 800,000 akWh consumed per year X 3 year agreement but paid partially up-front (1 year) and partially residual over the course of the contract agreement with supplier X .003 fee applied.
