As soon as a signed contract is returned, a separate department/personnel contacts the signer and follows a script to verify they were the signer and their understanding of the terms in the contract. All of the verification calls are also recorded and archived.

**d. OVERSIGHT OF MARKETING:** Explain all methods Applicant will use to ensure all marketing is performed in an ethical manner, for both employees and subcontractors.

There are no subcontractors. All employees are on-site and trained and monitored by us. Sales people have phone scripts including presentations and objection handlings that are practiced routinely. All phone calls are recorded and archived. There is a listen in function to hear live calls. There is a Sales Manager on the floor and an Operations Manager to oversee what is being said and done. Each of the main Closers have phone callers under them who they monitor. Our supplier contracts have agreements and some have codes on how to conduct ourselves when dealing with prospects and customers. We train our personnel on these procedures and enforce them. Our website and social media sites contain general information and invitations to contact us about our services. That covers all of our marketing. We have not had PUC complaints or lost any Supplier contracts for violations of the expected practices.

An EGS will file an annual report reporting for customer groups defined by annual usage. Reports must be filed using the appropriate report form that may be obtained from the PUC's Secretary's Bureau or the forms officer, or may be down-loaded from the PUC's internet web site.
  - Reports of Gross Receipts: Applicant shall report its Pennsylvania intrastate gross receipts to the Commission on a quarterly and year to date basis no later than 30 days following the end of the quarter.
  - The Treasurer or other appropriate officer of Applicant shall transmit to the Department of Revenue by March 15, an annual report, and under oath or affirmation, of the amount of gross receipts received by Applicant during the prior calendar year.

  - Applicant shall report to the Commission the percentages of total electricity supplied by each fuel source on an annual basis per 52 Pa. Code § 54.39(d).
  - Applicant will be required to meet periodic reporting requirements as may be issued by the Commission to fulfill the Commission's duty under Chapter 28 pertaining to reliability and to inform the Governor and Legislature of the progress of the transition to a fully competitive electric market.



# By the Commission:

On February 9, 2017, Utility Services Advisory Group, Inc. ("USAG-INC") filed with the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission") a verified Petition requesting to withdraw Utility Services Advisory Group, LLC's ("USAG-LLC") Certificate of Service Authority to operate as an agent, broker, or consultant ("ABC") and to have the Commission issue a new Certificate of Service Authority to operate as an ABC to USAG-INC. The Commission previously granted USAG-LLC authority to operate as an ABC in Docket No. 14-0624.

The Petition states that USAG-LLC changed its name to USAG-INC due to its conversion from a limited liability company to a corporation as part of an administrative reorganization in Florida. Attachment A to the Petition includes copies of the Office of the Illinois Secretary of State documentation for the withdrawal of USAG-LLC as a limited liability company and approval to transact business as USAG-INC. Attachment B to the Petition also includes a copy of a rider to the applicable ABC bond reflecting the name change and current address for USAG-INC. The Petition indicates that there will be no changes to any existing customer contracts. Additionally, the name change will not otherwise impact the legal ownership of USAG-INC. As part of the reorganization, two of the five managers have been removed from their management positions, however, they have retained their ownership.

As a practical matter, the only significant difference between USAG-INC and USAG-LLC is the legal form of the entity. The other difference, as noted above, is that two of the managers have been removed from their management positions as part of the reorganization. USAG-INC has demonstrated that it will continue to meet its managerial qualifications set forth in Section 454.60 through Attachment C to the Petition.

Attachment C contains a corporate organizational chart and identifies the occupational background information of the persons being used to meet the requirements of Section 454.60(a). Attachment C also contains occupational background information on the person or persons being used to meet the requirements of Section 454.60(a). Additionally, the same technical and financial resources that supported the former entity's Petition in Docket No. 14-0624 remain in place to support USAG-INC and its provision of service

The Commission finds that all the relief granted to USAG-LLC should be applicable to USAG-INC. Pursuant to 83 III. Adm. Code 200.640(a)(2), the Commission takes administrative notice of the record in Docket No. 14-0624. The Commission also notes that according to the website of the Office of the Illinois Secretary of State and the Certificate of Good Standing included in Attachment C to the Petition, USAG-INC is in good standing and authorized to transact business in Illinois.

All of the information to grant the requested relief was contained in the Petition; therefore, no hearing was necessary.

The Commission, having considered the record herein, is of the opinion and finds that:

- (1) USAG-INC is a Florida corporation authorized to transact business in Illinois and the successor of USAG-LLC, a Florida limited liability company;
- (2) USAG-LLC received authority to operate as an ABC in Docket No. 14-0624;
- (3) USAG-INC requests authority to continue to provide the same services to the same customers at the same rates and conditions as USAG-LLC;
- (4) although two of the managers have been removed from their management positions as part of the reorganization, USAG-INC has demonstrated that it continues to possess sufficient managerial resources and abilities to provide services as an ABC;
- (5) the same technical and financial resources that supported USAG-LLC continue to support USAG-INC and its provision of service;
- (6) the Certificate of Service Authority granted to USAG-LLC in Docket No. 14-0624 should be canceled and the service authority should be reissued to USAG-INC;
- (7) if not already filed, USAG-INC should file with the Office of the Chief Clerk of the Commission all documentation that was filed with the Office of the Illinois Secretary of State pertaining to the change in corporate entity from USAG-LLC to USAG-INC: and

(8) in all respects, the relief granted to USAG-LLC in Docket No. 14-0624 should be applicable to USAG-INC.


