SECTION 1

RULES & REGULATIONS

ITEM 10 - SCOPE OF CARRIER'S OPERATING AUTHORITY

Carrier is authorized to transport household goods, in use, between points in Pennsylvania.

ITEM 20 - GOVERNING PUPLICATIONS

Except as otherwise provided herein for rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory), revisions thereto and reissues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

ITEM 30 - DECLARED VALUE

Rates and charges named herein applicable when value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound, per article (see Governing Tariff).

Item 40 - PIANO CARRY

When a baby grand or grand piano is included in the move an additional charge of \$50.00 will be assessed.

◆ ITEM 50 - LABOR CHARGE

Carrier will assess a charge of \$38.00 per hour (Non-Peak Season) and \$45.00 per hour (Peak Season) labor charge when no other charges are otherwise provided in this tariff, when such services are requested by shipper or his agent.

ITEM 60 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY

Class 1 shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of each dwelling and such other similar property; except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of the householder and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

▲ ▼ ITEM 70 - PACKING AND UNPACKING SERVICE

Packing to be performed using rates in Freight PA. P.U.C. No. 50 (Tristate 50-T), Item 301. Schedule E rates shall apply for Non-Peak Season and Schedule F rates shall apply for Peak Season. Refer to Item 300 and Item 350 for definition of Non-Peak Season and Peak Season. Unpacking will be charged for at the hourly rates shown in Item 300 (Non-Peak Season) and Item 350 (Peak Season). Regular time and overtime charges will apply for both packing and unpacking as applicable.

ITEM 75 - PAYMENT

This carrier may elect to accept MasterCard or Visa credit cards as payment for all rates and charges, subject to the following notes below.

- Note 1: The application of this item is subject to authorization from MasterCard or Visa on each individual shipment.
- Note 2: This item will only apply to shipments transported between points in Pennsylvania.

Abbreviations, reference marks and symbols are explained on the last page of this tariff.

SECTION 1 RULES & REGULATIONS

ITEM 80 - FULL VALUE REPLACEMENT PROTECTION

Provisions of this rule will apply on the transportation of household goods, in use, between points in Pennsylvania for both shipments transported forty (40) miles and less and shipments transported in excess of forty (40) miles.

Full Value Protection will be provided by carrier only if shipment is declared at a minimum lump sum of \$10,000.00 or \$4.00 for each pound of weight in the shipment, whichever is greater.

SECTION 1 RULES & REGULATIONS

ITEM 85 - PICKUP OR DELIVERY TRANSPORTATION RATES ON STORAGE-IN-TRANSIT

- (a) Apply hourly rates shown in Item 300 herein. Minimum transportation charge eight (8) hours at rates named in Column 1 and Columns 2, 3 and 4 in Item 300 herein. Hourly rates apply on loading, actual movement or transportation and unloading (except as provided in (b) below).
- (b) Where storage-in-transit shipment is not unloaded at carrier's warehouse and shipment remains on carrier's vehicle, an overnight S.I.T. flat charge of \$150.00 per vehicle will be assessed.
- (c) Waiting charge will be assessed by carrier on the basis of a vehicle, driver and two helpers at the applicable hourly rates shown in Item 300 from 8:00AM following overnight S.I.T. flat charge until carrier's employees and equipment arrive at the customer's location for unloading. Thereafter, carrier's hourly rates in Item 300 will be assessed on the equipment and labor furnished by carrier from the commencement of unloading and dismissal of equipment and labor by shipper.

ITEM 90 - WAIVER OF MINIMUM CHARGE

When move is performed solely at the carrier's convenience, carrier shall not assess a minimum transportation charge. In such instances, carrier shall charge based on the actual time to complete the move plus the applicable travel time charge.

Traveling charges cover traveling to first point of origin and traveling from final destination, irrespective of the actual time involved in such traveling.

Hourly rates apply only from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin (continue during all loading, transportation from first point of origin to final destination and unloading) until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men by shipper at destination.
