**COMPLAINANT'S PETITION
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE MAIN BRIEF**

I, Pamela Scott, hereby file this petition for an extension of time to file Complainant's main brief due to the current pandemic and the Commission's Emergency Order Re: Suspension of Regulatory and Statutory Deadlines; Modification to Filing and Service Requirements, filed at Docket No. M-2020-3019262.

This petition is in response to the Interim Order Re-opening the Hearing Record and Permitting the Parties to File Main Briefs issued by Administrative Law Judge Jeffrey A. Watson on July 6, 2020

The Complainant would be severely disadvantaged by having to file her brief on or before July 24, 2020 without the benefit of being able to look at the hearing transcript.

In contrast to Duquesne Light Company's ability to have its ratepayers pay for their copy of the hearing transcript early on, the Complainant has limited financial resources that have been further aggravated by the pandemic and Complainant is unable to financially afford to pay the \$1,088 (\$3.06 per page) for a copy of the hearing transcript.

Given that the Commission's offices are all closed until further notice and that the Complainant thus is and has been unable to view a copy in the Commission's offices, Complainant requests that the parties be granted an extension of time to file their main briefs.

For the reasons set forth above, Complainant requests that the deadline for filing main briefs from both parties be extended beyond July 24, 2020 and that after the Commission's offices have reopened for public viewing of transcripts that a revised interim order be issued setting the deadline for filing main briefs in this matter.
