**I Declare,** all rights intrinsic or expressed shall never be prejudiced.

**I Declare,** all solicitations of contract are denied except for remedies approved by Noreen McCarthy in writing. All solicitations to contract with Noreen McCarthy without explicit consent shall be a violation of Noreen McCarthy's religious dictates of conscience.

**I Declare,** Noreen McCarthy reserves all rights to amend any and all instruments executed by Noreen McCarthy without prejudice.

Noreen McCarthy shall be proceeding by coercion and duress. Furthermore Noreen McCarthy evidences violations of 18 USC 241. 18 U.S.C. § 241.
