TUS-2 Reference the Agreement, Page 1, "Payment". Please provide a detailed explanation of the methodology used to determine the payment amount.

Response:

The method used to determine payment value of \$250,066.00 was two-fold. First, Brighton Township ("Township") utilized its process for competitive bidding pricing to perform road repaving, and obtained five bids. Second, Duquesne Light Company ("Duquesne Light") pursued its own independent bid for the same repaving work to compare with the Township's bids.

Duquesne Light selected the lowest bid price to determine the payment amount of \$250,066.00.
