Please do not dismiss this Complaint. Aqua Pennsylvania is increasing their rate by 50%, which is an unreasonable tariff. No monopoly utility should be allowed to gouge their customers in such a manner. In the answer and new matter response from Aqua Pennsylvania Inc on page 3 bottom paragraph, it states that a complainant seeking to evade the effect of an existing tariff provision carries a very heavy burden to prove the facts and circumstances have changed so drastically as to render the application of the tariff provision unreasonable. It is unreasonable to increase my previous cost of 800 dollars a year to 1200 hundred dollars for the year, which is a 50% increase, not a 2.43% estimated percentage increase they stated in docket no A-2019-3009052.

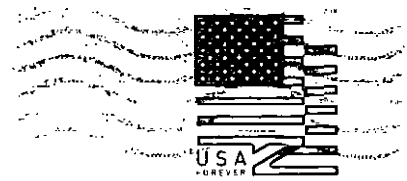
