To All It May Concern:

I am in receipt of a letter dated May 4, 2020 from Tori Geisler regarding an Interim Order issued on April 10, 2020 and my letter of response dated April 20, 2020.

Ms. Geisler states in her letter of May 4th that I wrote on April 20th, that I am "in no position at this time, when (she) will or will not be mentally competent to participate in an exhausting hearing". Using this statement, and taking it totally out of context is extremely insulting. I did affirm that my mental condition was in a state of pandemonium due to the following; a two year illness, five deaths of family members between July, 2020 and December 2020 and my beloved dog passing the day prior to receiving

a telephone call from a person named Renee of the PUC telling me that all correspondence would now be electronic. I also explained there is the obstacle of my computer not working properly making electronic communication impossible. My computer is approximately 15 years old, a large, desk top model with a huge heavy tower under my desk and I will need to have it repaired. This will entail getting someone to come to my home for repairs. Under the "stay at home" order, due to the national emergency, most businesses are closed preventing me from getting the help I need, especially a home service call. There is also the matter of not being able to get the needed supplies. I have regained some of my composure at this point but still don't know when I can get the computer repaired, certainly not before June 4th. This leaves the possibility of needing to buy a brand new computer and learning new programs. At almost 80 years of age this is a major task in itself. The last two years have taken a serious toll on my health and my ability to deal with this uncompromising issue.

Therefore, I am reiterating my position that, due to circumstances beyond my immediate control, I am not in a position to give anyone a definite date when these issues will be resolved and propose that a hearing be set on a certain date. The best I can offer is for a date to be set at the end of August, possibly the 25th or 26th and if things have not fallen in place I will have to notify you that I will not be available.

I am enclosing a copy of my letter dated April 20, 2020 for your review and expect that my situation will be respected and I will not have to deal with any more insulting statements.

To All It May Concern:

On April 10, 2020 I received a telephone message from a person named Renee asking for me to return her call. On April 13, 2020, I returned her call at 11:58 AM. She asked me for a current email address saying that the address on record was not correct. I did in fact give her my email address, telling her that I am having an ongoing problem with my email system and am not receiving or able to send emails most of the time. At last check I had approximately 600 emails I have not been able to retrieve.

She stated that my hearing scheduled for May 7, 2020 has been continued and all communication in the future will be conducted electronically. I explained that since my old, outdated computer is not working properly I may not be able to communicate in that manner and requested that I be notified by regular mail. I was told that was not possible because no mail is going out or coming into the PUC office. I also expressed to her that not only have I been through a lengthy illness, I have had five (5) family members die between July, 2020 and December, 2020 and was not even able to attend their funerals. I also lost my beloved dog on April 9, 2020. I am in no position to state at this time, when I will or will not be mentally competent to participate in an exhausting hearing.

Due to my more than stressful and chaotic last two years plus the national ongoing emergency (to say nothing of the expenses I have endured) I don't know how soon I will be able to take care of the computer problem. Someone will have to come to my home to resolve the computer issues. Since we're all under solitary confinement at the present time, repairs to my computer may not be possible anytime soon.

I am again requesting that communication take place by regular postal service.
