Your Honor:

In order to clarify any confusion regarding PPL Electric Utilities Corporation's ("PPL Electric" or the "Company") position regarding mediation, PPL Electric does not consent to mediation in this proceeding. The above-captioned proceeding has been ongoing for over fifteen (15) months and a hearing is scheduled to occur on August 6, 2020.

PPL Electric notes that, during this time, the Complainants have repeatedly sought to inundate the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") and PPL Electric with meritless, and at times frivolous, filings and submissions. Despite their willingness to make these filings and submissions—to which PPL Electric expended considerable time and resources responding—at no point prior to July 24, 2020, did the Complainants ever indicate to PPL Electric that they were willing to engage in the Commission's mediation processes. In addition, this request came shortly (approximately 2 weeks) before the evidentiary hearing schedule in this matter is scheduled to occur and includes a request to continue those hearings until mediation occurs.

The timing of this request, especially in light of the Complainants' conduct to date, leads PPL Electric to believe that mediation would not be productive and, moreover, that the Complainants' request for mediation is nothing more than an attempt to further delay these proceedings. As such, PPL Electric does not consent to participate in the mediation process requested by the Complainants.
