Secretary Chiavetta:

On July 29, 2020, the Complainants filed a letter (attached) with the Secretary's Bureau, requesting a Continuance in the hearing proceedings in the above-referenced case.

52 Pa. Code §§ 69.392, 69.394 and 69.395 state the following:

§ **69.392** (b) (1) Parties may request mediation, prior to the commencement of a proceeding, by sending a letter request to the Mediation Coordinator of OALJ, and a copy of the request to the Secretary of the Commission.

§ **69.394** (b) If the OALJ determines that the proceeding should not be set for mediation, the parties **will be notified** of this as well as the procedure to be used in lieu of mediation.

§ **69.395** (a) For cases in which hearings must be commenced within 90 days, a party's request for mediation shall be construed as a waiver of that requirement.

The Complainants have complied with § **69.392** (b) (1), having sent a letter requesting mediation to the Mediation Coordinator of OALJ and a copy of the request to the Secretary of the Commission.

The Complainants have not received an official determination by the OALJ of whether or not the proceeding should be set for mediation, nor have we received , pursuant to § **69.394** (b), official notification by the OALJ in the case that the proceeding should not be set for mediation.

A required hearing in this case is scheduled for Thursday, August 6, 2020, which is within 90 days of the date of this filing. In accordance with § **69.395** (a), the Complainants' request for mediation "**shall** be construed as a waiver of that requirement."

Accordingly, the Complainants again request a Continuance of the hearing in this case until after all of the conditions specified under provisions 69.392, 69.394 and 69.395 of Title 52 of the Pa. Code have been satisfied.

As the date of the scheduled hearing in this case is seven (7) days from the date of the filing of this letter, this request and the previous request by the Complainants for a Continuance of the hearing are timely filed.
