Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Please be advised that Metropolitan Edison Company (“Met-Ed” or “the Company”) will not be filing exceptions regarding the above-referenced matter.

This letter also serves to advise that this morning, Met-Ed was sent an email advising that the Complainant is seeking an extension to the time period for which to submit exceptions. Met-Ed strongly opposes that request, on the basis that the time requested is wildly in excess of normal extensions granted. Additionally, the Company notes that Ms. Bae herself helped select the date for hearing set in this matter, as well as advised counsel for Met-Ed that she knowingly did not show up to her hearing and accepted that this meant her case would be dismissed in her absence. Notably, she never once cited family health issues, but rather, placed the blame on her summer being too busy with her artistic work for which she was traveling out of state. For these reasons, the request for extension should be denied or, at the least, limited to a brief extension of up to September 8, which effectively doubles the time allotted for response.
