

RULES & REGULATIONS

**ITEM 5 - SCOPE OF CARRIER'S OPERATING AUTHORITY**

To transport, as a motor carrier, household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania - PA P.U.C. Certificate No. A-00108228.

**ITEM 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS**

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, except as otherwise provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), supplements thereof and reissues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

**ITEM 20 - RELEASED VALUE**

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article. For method of determining rates, when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound per article, see Conversion Table of Rates, Section 4 of Governing Tariff.

**ITEM 30 - PACKING AND UNPACKING**

Packing and unpacking service provided by carrier will be assessed on the hourly rates contained in Section 3 herein plus Packing Container Charges as provided in Item 100 herein.

SECTION 2  
SCHEDULE OF RATES

ITEM 300-F (Cancels Item 300-D)

Applicable to transportation of household goods, in use, traveling distances of 40 miles and less between points in Pennsylvania.

Subject to Notes AA and 1 to 3 below. The transportation charges on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE named in Column 1 plus HOURLY CHARGE at the applicable rates named in Columns 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9.

Hourly rates apply only from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin (continuing during all loading, transportation from first point of origin to final destination and unloading) until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men by shipper at destination.

Traveling charges cover traveling to first point of origin and traveling from final destination, irrespective of actual time involved in such traveling.

NOTE 1 - Traveling charges (Column 1) are in addition to hourly rates (Columns 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9).

NOTE 2 - Hourly rates (Columns 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9) computed in half-hour periods; fractions of one-half hour are considered as one-half hour.

▲ NOTE 3 - Minimum transportation charges on Saturday, Sundays and Holidays: Four (4) hours at rates named under WEEKEND RATES in Columns 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9.

NOTE AA - Travel charge to be based on the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 and will apply as follows based on the combined actual road miles from the carrier's terminal to the first point of origin and from final destination back to carrier's terminal using Mileage Guide No. 40 or a software program designed to calculate mileage, such as, Google Maps or MapQuest.

0 - 15 miles	1/2 hour
16 - 30 miles	1 hour
31 - 45 miles	1 1/2 hours
46 - 60 miles	2 hours

For mileage in excess of 60 miles, a travel time charge of 1/2 hour will be assessed for each additional 15 miles.
