An evidentiary hearing in this proceeding was held on February 20, 2020. Upon conclusion of the hearing, the Parties were advised that an order would be entered addressing a briefing schedule.

On April 7, 2020, an interim order was entered permitting the filing of briefs on or before May 29, 2020.

On May 21, 2020, due to the Covid Pandemic and subsequent Pennsylvania Emergency Declaration, Complainants submitted a request to extend the deadline for the submission of briefs in this proceeding.

On May 28, 2020, an interim order was entered extending the deadline to file briefs until July 10, 2020.

On July 1, 2020, due to the ongoing Covid Pandemic and Pennsylvania Emergency Declaration, Complainants submitted another request to extend the deadline for the submission of briefs in this proceeding. On July 6, 2020, Respondent provided an email response indicating Respondent did not oppose a reasonable extension of the briefing schedule.

On July 6, 2020 an interim order was entered extending the deadline to file briefs until September 1, 2020.

Now, on August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2020, we request a further extension of the briefing schedule due to the ongoing Covid 19 Pandemic and Pennsylvania Emergency Declaration:
