Re: **Failure to Submit Assessment Report**

Dear Sir or Madam,

Your company has not yet filed an assessment report for the 2019 calendar year. The purpose of this letter is to give you one final opportunity to submit your assessment report. The 2019 Assessment Report was mailed on February 12, 2020 to your company. If the company is no longer in need of their PUC Authority, the Commission requires the submission of a letter containing a statement that the service is no longer being rendered.

Pursuant to the Public Utility Code, each utility shall file with the Commission each year an assessment report, on a form provided by the Commission (AR-19-MC) showing gross Commonwealth intrastate revenues for assessment purposes, such assessment report to be filed by March 31, covering the proceeding calendar year under 66 Pa.C.S. § 510 (relating to assessment for regulatory expenses upon public utilities). A copy of this year's report can be located at http://www.puc.pa.gov/filing_resources/motor_carrier_online_forms.aspx.

If we do not receive your 2019 assessment report within twenty (20) days, this office will refer this matter to the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E) for prosecution. Should this happen, your business will be subject to a civil penalty of up to \$1,000 per day for each day that the assessment is past due, as well as suspension or revocation of your certificate of public convenience and suspension or revocation of your vehicle registration with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (for motor carriers).

To avoid prosecution, mail your 2019 Assessment Report to the following address:
