Robert C. Haehn started working in Ohio's deregulated energy industry in October 2009 when he accepted a position as a Business Development Manager with an alternative electric supplier. As a lifelong resident of Ohio, Mr. Haehn was well positioned to work with business customers in his home state. In November 2010 Mr. Haehn became an independent agent and in 2012 he applied and was

approved for commercial electric and natural gas brokerage licenses by The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio. He became active with his licenses in June 2012.

Since acquiring his own license and starting Summit Power Brokers, LLC, a commercial energy brokerage firm, Mr. Haehn has acquired a large number of commercial accounts as of 12-31-20. Since 2012 Summit Power Brokers, LLC has secured deregulated electric contracts for commercial customers in Ohio totaling over 100 million kilowatt hours.

The principal business interests of Mr. Haehn and his energy brokerage firm are to provide electric and natural gas brokerage services to commercial customers in Ohio and Texas. Summit Power Brokers, LLC is applying for a commercial Broker/Marketers electric license in Pennsylvania.

Mr. Haehn benefits from client referrals but mostly uses a strategy of cold calling to expand his customer base. Summit Power Brokers, LLC will use a combination of current customer referrals, online advertising, mail marketing and cold calling to grow the electric brokerage business in Pennsylvania.

Summit Power Brokers, LLC dba BrokerCity.Biz does not service residential accounts. The company uses a very targeted marketing campaign for specific commercial accounts. Some commercial accounts are acquired through referrals. Other commercial accounts are acquired with mail campaigns and through cold calling.

Summit Power Brokers, LLC dba BrokerCity.Biz is a privately held small business. The company's only employee is its president Robert C. Haehn. The company has never used subcontractors. The deregulated electric market is fiercely competitive and the company has no immediate plans to use any subcontractors.

Summit Power Brokers, LLC dba BrokerCity.Biz may use a door to door marketing campaign for commercial accounts only from time to time. The only person authorized to market door to door commercial electric brokerage services is the president Robert C. Haehn.
