

Energy Transfer Company Data Request Response

Energy Transfer Company did not sell or decommission assets reported with the ACT 127 Submittals for the prior year ending in 2018 or for the year ending in 2019 for the counties listed. The mileage differences from 2018 to 2019 submittals were related to GIS data corrections. Summary provided in the table below.
