Dear Administrative Law Judge Barnes:

PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric” or the “Company”) hereby files this letter response to the “Reply to Respondent’s Answer In Opposition to Motion to Remove Sanctions (Amended)” filed by John and Janet Holder and June Maculesky (“Complainants”) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) at the above-captioned docket on September 23, 2020 (hereinafter the “Improper Reply”).<sup>1</sup>

PPL Electric objects to the Complainants’ improper attempt to—once again—re-litigate prior rulings issued by Your Honor, for the reasons previously stated in: (a) PPL Electric’s Motion in Limine and Motion for Sanctions dated February 28, 2020; (b) PPL Electric’s June 22, 2020 Reply to the Complainants’ Exceptions to ALJ Order granting Respondent’s Motion in Limine; (c) PPL Electric’s June 22, 2020 Reply to the Complainants’ Exceptions to ALJ Order Granting Respondent’s Motion for Sanctions; and (d) PPL Electric’s September 14, 2020 Answer to the Motion to Remove Sanctions and Motion to File Amended Brief of the Complainants (“September 14 Answer”).

In addition, the Complainants' latest Improper Reply attempt to contest Your Honor's May 26, 2020 Order Granting PPL Electric Utilities Corporation's Motion in Limine and Motion for Sanctions ("Order Granting Sanctions"). Complainants have been afforded due process of law with respect to the Order Granting Sanctions and should not be permitted to revisit this order for a third time.

Finally, the Complainants' Improper Reply does not constitute a permissible pleading before the Commission. The Improper Reply is essentially an "answer to an answer to a motion," as it responds to PPL Electric's September 14 Answer. Section 5.103 of the Commission's regulations, 52 Pa. Code § 5.103, does not permit a party to file an answer to an answer to a motion.

For all of these reasons, and for the reasons more fully explained in PPL Electric's prior submissions in this matter, the Complainants' Improper Reply should be rejected.
