SECTION 1 RULES & REGULATIONS

Item 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, between points in Pennsylvania, except as otherwise specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

Item 20 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY

Class 1 shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property: except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

Item 30 - DECLARED VALUE

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article. For method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound per article, see Governing Tariff.

SECTION 2 ADDITIONAL SERVICE CHARGES

Item 200 - (concluded)

- 1. Packing rates include only the packing service of carrier furnished containers.
- 2. Unpacking rates include unpacking service of containers furnished and packed by carrier and disposal of such containers and materials if requested by consignee. Unpacking services, if ordered, must be performed at time of delivery unless consignee requests otherwise. If consignee requests that unpacking of carrier packed items be performed subsequent to the time of delivery, the unpacking charges provided will apply subject to the minimum charges shown. Apply hourly rates in Item 350 herein for unpacking of all containers not packed or furnished by the carrier.
- 3. When delivery of containers prior to performance of transportation or pickup of containers after performance of transportation is required by shipper, hourly charges as shown in Item 350 will apply.
- ▲ 4. When packing materials are delivered to a customer within 20 miles of carrier's terminal, charge will be \$50.00 and when packing materials are delivered to a customer over 20 miles up to 40 miles inclusive from carrier's terminal, charge will be \$75.00. If packing materials are delivered in excess of 40 miles from carrier's terminal, charge will be \$25.00 per each additional 20 miles.

SECTION 3 HOURLY RATES

Item 350

Applicable on the transportation of household goods in use (Class 1 Shipments) - (see Item 20) transported distances of forty (40) miles and less.

Subject to Notes AA and 1 to 7 below. The transportation charges on any shipment shall be a <u>COMBINATION</u> of the applicable <u>TRAVELING CHARGE</u> named in Column 1 plus <u>HOURLY CHARGE</u> at the applicable rates named in Columns 2, 3 and 4.

Hourly rates apply only from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin (continue during all loading, transportation from first point of origin to final destination, and unloading) until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men by shipper at destination.

Traveling charges cover traveling to first point of origin and traveling from final destination, irrespective of actual time involved in such traveling.

▲ NOTE 4 - Minimum total transportation charge on Sundays and Holidays (any hour): two and one-half (2.5) hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 2. Minimum total transportation charge Saturdays (any hour) and Weekdays, 6:01PM to 5:59AM: two and one-half (2.5) hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 4. Minimum transportation charge Weekdays, 6:00AM to 6:00PM: two and one-half (2.5) hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 3.

NOTE 5 - Carrier will supply and charge for supervisor or supervisors as requested by shipper. Hourly rate for each supervisor will be computed from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men at final destination unless other time of arrival or dismissal of supervisor is provided by agreement between shipper and carrier.

A NOTE 6 - Any work performed on same day in excess of nine (9) hours Weekdays, 6:00AM to 6:00PM, will be subject to overtime charges shown in Column 4 above. Any work performed on same day Sundays & Holidays; Saturdays, or Weekdays, 6:01PM to 5:59AM, in excess of nine (9) hours will be subject to overtime charges shown in Column 2 above.

▲ NOTE 7 - For shipments with stairs, and additional of charge of \$20.00 per flight for each level, up or down, will apply in addition to the hourly charges in Item 350.

A NOTE AA - Travel charge to be based on the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, and 4 and will apply as follows based on the combined actual road miles from the carrier's terminal to the first point of origin and from final destination back to carrier's terminal using Mileage Guide No. 40 or a software program designed to calculate mileage, such as, Google Maps, MapQuest, or TruckRouter.

0 to 10 miles 1/2 hour over 10 to 20 miles 1 hour over 20 to 30 miles 1 1/2 hours over 30 to 40 miles 2 hours

For mileage in excess of 40 miles, a travel time charge of 1/2 hour will be assessed for each additional 10 miles.
