Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on July 30, 2020 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of West Penn Power Company (“WPP”). Mr. and Mrs. Kollmar have failed to provide notification of any expert and factual witnesses by August 14, 2020, in accordance with the Interim Order. WPP timely provided notice of its expert and factual witnesses. Additionally, on October 15, 2020, WPP filed a Motion to Stay Proceedings which is currently pending before Administrative Law Judge Emily DeVoe.

Should WPP’s Motion be denied, WPP anticipates that the Complainants will not be presenting testimony in this matter or, if they do, it will be limited to their own factual testimony at the time of any evidentiary hearing. Therefore, WPP anticipates that it will only need to present one witness, Mr. John Ahr, in order to rebut any factual testimony offered at that time.

Despite repeated efforts through various channels, counsel for WPP has been unable obtain dates from Mr. and Mrs. Kollmar in order to ascertain their availability for hearing, Mr. and Mrs. Kollmar have refused to provide such availability. Given the lack of input, should WPP’s Motion be denied, WPP requests that a one-day telephonic evidentiary hearing be scheduled. Counsel for WPP and its witness are available for a hearing in November 2020 as follows: November 2, 4-5, 12-13, 16-18, or 30, 2020.
