Dear Mr. LaTorre:

Philadelphia Gas Works ("PGW") is aware that Paragon Advisors LLC has filed an application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to supply natural gas services to the public in Pennsylvania and specifically within the services territory of Philadelphia Gas Works.

As you know, in making such an application, Paragon Advisors LLC must furnish acceptable security to each utility where Paragon Advisors LLC will do business. As such, under its tariff, Philadelphia Gas Works could require Paragon Advisors LLC to provide a bond or other financial security instrument in an amount that Philadelphia Gas Works determines to be appropriate.

However, you have indicated, and it is Philadelphia Gas Works' understanding, that Paragon Advisors LLC intends only to provide natural gas aggregating, brokering and consulting services at this time. You have stated that in performing these services Paragon Advisors LLC will never take title to any delivered natural gas.

Based upon your representations, Philadelphia Gas Works has determined that, at this time, Paragon Advisors LLC does not need to post a bond or other form of security to operate in its service territory. If the services provided by Paragon Advisors LLC should change, Philadelphia Gas Works reserves the right to require security from Paragon Advisors LLC as it deems appropriate.

On April 10, 2015, Paragon Advisors, LLC ("Company") filed an Application for a License to Supply Electricity or Electric Generation Services in Maryland under COMAR 20.51. The Company proposes to provide electricity supplier services in Maryland for commercial and industrial customers as described in the application. Additional information was filed on July 7, 2015.

After considering this matter at the July 22, 2015 Administrative Meeting, the Commission granted the Company a license to supply electricity or electric generation services in Maryland (License Reference Number IR-3504). The license granted by the Commission under this Letter Order is limited solely to electricity supplier broker services for the customer classes and service territories applied for and recommended by Staff. Additionally, the Company is directed to provide marketing and training materials specific to its Maryland operations to the Commission Staff 30 days prior to commencing operations in Maryland.

Finally, the Company is reminded that it is under a continuing obligation to notify the Commission within 30 days of any changes to the information upon which the Commission relied in granting this license. A copy of the supplemental or updated information is required to be filed concurrently with the Office of People's Counsel.

DECISION

I. INTRODUCTION

A. SUMMARY

In this Decision, the Department of Public Utility Control grants Paragon Advisors LLC an Electric Aggregator Certificate of Registration to serve commercial, industrial and municipal customers in Connecticut.

B. BACKGROUND OF THE PROCEEDING

By application filed October 9, 2006 (Application) pursuant to § 16-245(I) of the General Statutes of Connecticut (Conn. Gen. Stat.), Paragon Advisors LLC (Paragon or

Company) applied to the Department of Public Utility Control (Department) for a registration to operate as an electric aggregator within Connecticut.

C. CONDUCT OF THE PROCEEDING

No Party requested a hearing. The Department determined that a hearing was not necessary in this matter; and thus, none was held. Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-245(I)(4).

D. PARTIES TO THE PROCEEDING

The Department recognized Paragon Advisors LLC, 170 Boston Post Road, Suite 105, Madison, Connecticut 06443; and the Office of Consumer Counsel, Ten Franklin Square, New Britain, Connecticut 06051, as Parties to the proceeding.

II. DEPARTMENT ANALYSIS

Paragon proposed to serve commercial, industrial and municipal customers throughout Connecticut. Paragon's headquarters are located at 170 Boston Post Road, Suite 105, Madison, Connecticut 06443. The Company's main telephone number is 203-245-9131. Paragon is a limited liability company formed on May 13, 2005 in Connecticut. Its contact person for regulatory matters is Tom LaTorre. Application, p. 2. Paragon has no affiliates or subsidiaries. Application, Exhibit A-11. Paragon provided its 2006 Profit and Loss Statement along with a 2006 and 2007 budget. Response to Interrogatory EL-1.

Pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-245(I)(3), the Company disclosed that neither Paragon nor any of its officers are currently under investigation or have ever been fined, sanctioned or penalized in any state for violation of any consumer protection law or regulation. Application, A-14. Further, Paragon also affirmed that it will comply with the National Labor Relations Act and the Connecticut Unfair Trade Practices Act and applicable regulations. Application, Affidavit #2.

III. CONCLUSION AND ORDERS

A. CONCLUSION

After reviewing the Application, the Department grants Paragon a Certificate of Registration to provide electric aggregation services to commercial, industrial and municipal customers in the state of Connecticut. Paragon is reminded that it is under a continuing obligation to notify the Department of any changes to the information provided in the Application.

B. ORDERS

1. Paragon shall provide the Department with any changes to its customer service practices, procedures, or policies in writing at least ten (10) business days prior to the effective date of such changes.

2. Paragon shall maintain its customer complaint records to indicate: (1) the date of the complaint; (2) the name and address of the complainant; (3) the address or location of the complaint; (4) a description of the complaint; and (5) a description of the resolution of the complaint.
