I am specifically responding to answers by number:

#3. This is not a variable price, this was a constantly increasing price.

#5. I indeed have grounds. I was overcharged. This should not be dismissed

#6. No statute of limitations should apply

#11. I was overcharged. I would like to proceed with a hearing. If Energy Plus would prefer to have "judicial economy" they may reimburse me for the amount they overcharged me.

#14. I did not allege that Energy Plus changed the... "Variable place frequently enough." I assert that they gradually increased my price. It is clear from my price history that the price gradually increased, and significantly. This was not "variable" regardless of what definition one uses. This was constantly increasing. I do not "overlook the many other factors". Instead, I would have preferred being treated fairly.

#16. As stated before, the pricing was very confusing as presented on the bill. It took me years to realize that the price was gradually increasing. I am not alleging that the "price did vary but not as frequently as he thinks it should have." Instead, I am arguing that the price increased unfairly and substantially.

#17. I am not alleging that the price "did not change often enough" but that it was unfairly increased, and substantially

#21. I do not allege that I was promised any savings. All I want was a fair pricing structure. I was clearly overcharged. Look at my initial rate versus the rate those that gradually increased.

#22. The "factual avertments" are simply the gradually increasing rate over time

#23. There is good reason to go forward with his hearing. I should be reimbursed for my overcharged bills

#27. I am not part of that class action suit as I was never aware of it.
