SECTION 1
RULES & REGULATIONS

ITEM 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, except as otherwise specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

ITEM 20 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY

Class 1 shipments are person effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property: except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

ITEM 30 - DECLARED VALUE

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound, per article. For method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound, per article, see Governing Tariff.

ITEM 40 - ADDITIONAL EXPENSES

Any parking fees incurred at the client's origin or destination will be the responsibility of the client and added to the carrier's charges.

HOURLY RATES

Subject to Notes 1 to 5 and AA below, the transportation charges on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE named in Column 1 plus HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns 2, 3, and 4.

Hourly rates apply from the time of arrival to first point of origin (continued during all loading, transportation from first point of origin, as well as any extra stops, to final destination & unloading and dismissal of vehicle and men by shipper at destination.

The rates shown below apply to moves originating in the Counties of Bucks and Montgomery traveling 40 miles or less to points in Pennsylvania.

- Note AA - Travel charge to be based on the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, and 4 and will apply as follows based on the combined actual road miles from the carrier's terminal to the first point of origin and from final destination back to carrier's terminal using Mileage Guide No. 40 or a software program designed to calculate mileage, such as, Google Maps or MapQuest.

0-10 miles	1/2 hour
11-20 miles	1 hour
21-40 miles	1 1/2 hours
41-60 miles	2 hours

For mileage in excess of 60 miles, a travel time charge of 1/2 hour will be assessed for each additional 20 miles.

** Rates shown apply to moves traveling 40 miles or less and in excess of 40 miles within Pennsylvania.

LOCAL FUEL COST RECOVERY CHARGE

The following Fuel Cost Recovery Surcharge will apply as follows on shipments of household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania, transported distances of forty (40) miles and less.

- (a) The Fuel Cost Recovery Surcharge will be calculated using a "BASE PRICE PER GALLON" of \$1.267.
- (b) On the first Monday of each calendar month, the "CENTRAL ATLANTIC" average price per gallon of diesel fuel will be determined based on the price stated by the U. S. Department of Energy (DOE), Energy Information Administration (EIA) survey of "Retail-On-Highway Diesel Prices." This price will be obtained by calling the DOE Fuel Hot Line at 202-586-6966 or via the DOE Internet Website at www.eia.doe.gov.
- (c) If the first Monday of the calendar month is a federal holiday, the price will be determined based on the stated DOE price available on the next subsequent business day (Tuesday).
- (d) The DOE fuel price obtained will then become effective on the fifteenth (15th) day of the same month. The adjustment determined will apply for shipments loaded beginning on the 15th day of the month and remain in effect through the 14th day of the subsequent following month starting from the effective date of this item.

THIS PROCESS WILL CONTINUE MONTH AFTER MONTH BASED ON THE "NEW" MONTHLY FUEL COSTS.

FOR EXAMPLE

If the reported price of self-service diesel fuel determined on Monday, 10/01/2018, is \$3.447 per gallon, that amount will apply for the purpose of calculating the difference between that amount and the base price of \$1.267 per gallon for shipments loaded as of October 15, 2018 to November 14, 2018.

TO DETERMINE THE FUEL ADJUSTMENT AMOUNT TO APPLY, FIRST DETERMINE THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE "BASE PRICE PER GALLON" AND THE MOST CURRENT SELF-SERVICE DIESEL FUEL PRICE PER GALLON.

**SECTION 2
TRANSPORTATION RATES**

Rates are in cents per 100 pounds, apply to actual weight (subject to minimum weights as provided in rules herein) and include loading and unloading and the actual movement or transportation of property from origin to destination, but do not include Additional Services and Charges shown in Section 1. These rates apply to moves originating in the Counties of Bucks and Montgomery traveling in excess of 40 miles within Pennsylvania.

Break Point indicates weight at which a lower charge develops by use of lowest weight and applicable rate in next higher weight bracket.
