**REPLY TO RESPONDENT’S
MOTION TO STAY PROCEEDING**

On July 23, 2020, Valerie and Christopher Watson (Complainants) filed a formal Complaint (Complaint) against PECO Energy Company (PECO or Respondent) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). By Hearing Cancellation/Reschedule Notice dated September 18, 2020, an Initial Call-In Telephonic Hearing was scheduled for November 12, 2020, at 10:00 a.m.

On October 30, 2020, the Respondent filed a Motion to Stay Proceeding pursuant to a Civil Complaint filed in the Court of Common Pleas. The New Matter was accompanied by a Notice to Plead stating any reply must be filed within 20 days.

We oppose the motion. This case has been pending for several months, and the PUC already overruled PECO’s preliminary objection and concluded it has jurisdiction over the matters before it. This last-minute filing is nothing more than an attempt by PECO to delay adjudication of this proceeding and resolve these issues in a timely manner.

In addition, our Formal Complaint raises issues that are not likely to be directly addressed by the Civil Complaint proceeding – for example, our claim that PECO has not properly maintained its facilities on the property. These arguments have been outlined in our Watson’s Response to New Matter section 13.

Based upon the foregoing, we respectfully request that the Commission continue with the hearing set before Your Honor on November 12, 2020.
