

Reply to Preliminary Objections of Viridian Energy PA LLC

- I. I am submitting my reply in disagreement of the Preliminary Objections filed by Viridian Energy on October 26, 2020. In Viridian's Preliminary Objections, a three year statute of limitations is mentioned. I have spoken to Viridian and their attorney's regarding this matter and it is the first time I am hearing of this "statute of limitations." Regardless, the statute of limitations would not apply in this matter! I only became aware (in winter 2020) that my energy supplier was Viridian. I am still waiting to be told how I was enrolled in PECO's Standard Offer Program to receive electric generation service from Viridian. PECO told me that this is information that Viridian has to supply to me! Viridian tells me PECO has to provide it to me. I am still waiting to know how and by whom this program was authorized. In conclusion, I did not request to be enrolled in the Standard Offer Program and only found out about Viridian this past winter, not even one year ago. Therefore the statute of limitations would NOT apply.

- II. I respectfully request that this Commission consider my reply to Viridian's Preliminary Objections and NOT dismiss my complaint. Please also grant to me any relief which is deemed appropriate and reasonable.
