(b) Complaint filed September 9, 1980. Hearings held January 28, 1981, August 14, 1982 and November 27, 1985. Orders adopted May 29, 1981, December 3, 1982 and April 24, 1986. The last order directed Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to construct a replacement structure. Department reported May 1, 1989, that replacement structure was completed January 9, 1989. Department submitted November 7, 1989 summary of costs incurred. Total costs approved December 14, 1989, and parties authorized to pay ordered reimbursements. No further action necessary.

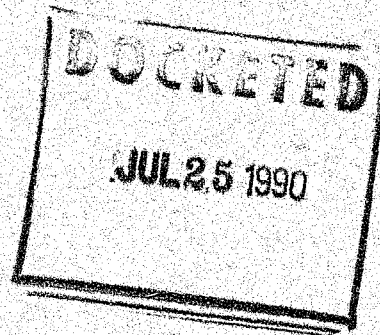

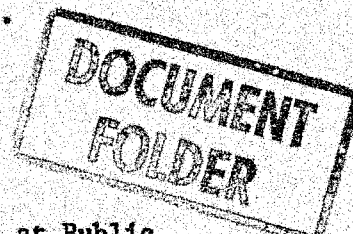
