



SECTION 1
RULES & REGULATIONS

ITEM 10 - SCOPE OF CARRIER'S OPERATING AUTHORITY

Rates and provisions named in this tariff, or as amended, are limited in their application on Pennsylvania intrastate traffic to the extent of the operating rights set forth herein, to transport, as a motor carrier, household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania.

ITEM 20 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, except as otherwise specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

ITEM 30 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY

Class 1 shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property: except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

ITEM 40 - DECLARED VALUE

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article. For the method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound per article, see Governing Tariff.

ITEM 50 - PIANO CARRY CHARGES

When a piano is part of the shipment, carrier will assess the following charges in addition to the applicable hourly rates published herein.

Spinnet	\$100.00
Baby Grand	\$100.00
Upright	\$100.00

If flights are involved in the relocation, an additional charge of \$50.00 per flight will apply.

ITEM 60 - PACKING AND UNPACKING CHARGES

Packing and unpacking will be performed on an hourly basis plus the cost of containers (Item 100), and such labor will be charged for at labor rates shown in Section 3, Item 300 herein.

Abbreviations, reference marks and symbols are explained on last page of tariff.

SECTION 2
ADDITIONAL SERVICE CHARGES

ITEM 200 - PACKING CONTAINER CHARGES

(When furnished to shipper by carrier). Rates are in dollars and cents per each unit, except as noted. (Applicable on shipments transported under forty (40) miles).

NOTE A - Cubical content must be shown on all cartons.

NOTE B - In the event that two or more standard containers must be joined together because of the size, shape or character of the item or items to be packed, the charge for the container shall be the combined charge for all cartons used.

SECTION 2
SCHEDULE OF RATES

ITEM 300 - HOURLY RATES

▲ Applicable on the transportation of household goods shipments traveling between points in Pennsylvania and transported distances of forty (40) miles and less.

Subject to Notes AA and 1 to 6 below, the transportation charges on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE named in Column 1 plus HOURLY CHARGES at the applicable rates named in Columns 2, 3, and 4.

Hourly rates apply only from time of arrival of vehicle(s) and men at first point of origin (continued during all loading, transportation from first point of origin to final destination, including any extra stops, and unloading) until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicle(s) and men by the shipper at final destination.

NOTE 1 - Traveling charges (Column 1) are in addition to hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4).

NOTE 2 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) are based on the day or days, or periods of days, as indicated, during which services are performed.

NOTE 3 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) are computed in half-hour periods; fractions of one-half hour considered one-half hour.

NOTE 4 - Minimum transportation charges - Sundays and Holidays (any hour): eight (8) hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 2. Saturdays (any hour) and Weekdays (5:01PM to 7:00AM): four (4) hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 4.

NOTE 5 - Rates in Column 4 apply only from 5:01PM to 12:00 midnight on any day when a higher rate is shown for the following day.

NOTE 6 - Carrier will supply and charge for supervisor or supervisors as requested by shipper. Hourly rate for each supervisor will be computed from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men at final destination unless other time of arrival or dismissal is provided by agreement between shipper and carrier.

NOTE AA - Travel charge to be based on the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, and 4 and will apply as follows based on the combined actual road miles from the carrier's terminal to the first point of origin and from final destination back to carrier's terminal using Mileage Guide No. 40 or a software program designed to calculate mileage, such as, Google Maps, MapQuest or TruckRouter.

0 - 20 miles	1 hour
21 - 40 miles	1 1/2 hours
41 - 60 miles	2 hours
For mileage in excess of 60 miles, a travel time charge of 1/2 hour will be assessed for each additional 20 miles.
