

My response to the New Matter is stated in the PUC Formal Complaint Form on page 3 item #5 Requested Relief. No where in the Requested Relief statement is there a mention of a monetary request for loss or damages for relocation of power lines on private property.

My request is for reimbursement of \$2968.31 which I contend is a billing issue for a miss-application of the New Service/New Business program. Many factors were not taken into consideration when the PECO ENERGY engineering group made their determination.

Inaccuracies are also contained in the BCS informal complaint decision and no discussions with me were made available prior to the complaint being dismissed.

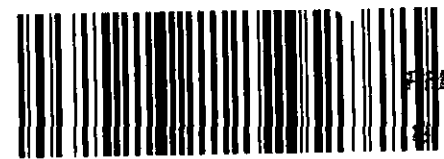

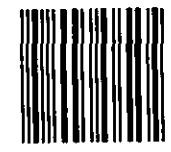
