

SECTION 1
RULES & REGULATIONS

ITEM 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, except as otherwise specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

ITEM 20 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY

Class 1 shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property: except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

ITEM 30 - DECLARED VALUE

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article. For the method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound per article, see Governing Tariff.

ITEM 50 - MINIMUM CHARGES

On moves transported 40 miles and less, a minimum charge based on three (3) hours plus applicable travel time will apply. For moves transported in excess of 40 miles, the minimum weight will be 1,000 pounds.

ITEM 70 - STAIR CARRIES, ELEVATORS, AND EXCESSIVE DISTANCES

On moves transported in excess of 40 miles, the following additional charges will apply when there are stair carries, elevators, or excessive distances as part of the move:

STAIR CARRY - \$50.00 per each 1,000 pounds or portion thereof per flight

ELEVATOR - \$150.00 per 1,000 pounds per elevator

EXCESSIVE DISTANCE - \$150.00 per 1,000 pounds for each 30 yards or portion thereof after the first 30 yards

SECTION 2

ADDITIONAL SERVICE CHARGES

ITEM 100 - WASHER & DRYER

When a washer and/or dryer are included in any shipment (40 miles & under or in excess of 40 miles), an additional charge of \$50.00 per appliance will apply. Customer is responsible for having water lines disconnected and/or reconnected as carrier will not touch water lines due to liability. Gas appliances must be disconnected and/or reconnected by a third party vendor with arrangements to be made by the customer.

ITEM 110 - UPRIGHT PIANO, OTHER BULKY ITEMS, AND HOISTING

The following additional charges will apply on any shipment (40 miles & under or in excess of 40 miles):
 UPRIGHT PIANO - \$125.00 per upright piano plus \$35.00 for each flight
 BULKY ITEM (riding lawnmower, small safe, grandfather clock, canoe/kayak, etc.) - \$150.00 per bulky item
 HOISTING FEE - \$150.00 to \$250.00 depending on hoisting required

ITEM 150 - CONTAINERS

When cartons are requested by the customer on moves transported forty (40) miles and less and moves transported in excess of forty (40) miles, the following charges will apply for containers:

NOTE 3 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4) computed in quarter-hour (15minutes) periods; fractions of one-quarter hour (15 minutes) considered as one-quarter hour (15 minutes).

NOTE 4 - When customer requests packing labor to be performed in conjunction with the move, add \$40.00 per hour to applicable rates shown above.

NOTE AA - Travel charge to be based on the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, and 4 and will apply as follows based on the combined actual road miles from the carrier's terminal to the first point of origin and from final destination back to carrier's terminal using Mileage Guide No. 40 or a software program designed to calculate mileage, such as, Google Maps, MapQuest or TruckRouter.

0 - 19 miles	1 hour
20 - 29 miles	1 1/2 hours
30 - 40 miles	2 hours

For mileage in excess of 40 miles, a travel time charge of 1/2 hour will be assessed for each additional 10 miles.
