**RE: Benjamin Kroop v. Duquesne Light Company**

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

I am filing a motion to separate case C-2020-3022330 and C-2020-3023135 which were consolidated. I object to Duquesne Light Company's Motion to Consolidate the Formal Complaints.

I attempted to file an objection, but was unable to because I was not provided instructions for submitting a response to Duquesne's original motion to consolidate. I called the PUC and left messages asking for a return call to ask clarifying questions, but never received a return call. The resources that I was pointed to by a PUC representative via email were missing from the website and the links have been broken since at least October. Secretary Chiavetta has confirmed that the documentation was missing from the website.

The two cases should not have been consolidated. They are completely unrelated issues. One is a billing dispute over unreasonable termination of service more than a year ago. The second is a dispute over reliability of service in recent months.
