Please confirm that PAWC-WD is requesting approval of the right of PAWC-WD to offer, render, furnish and supply wastewater treatment service to the public in an additional portion of Fairview Township, York County.

Response: PAWC inadvertently overlooked this portion of Fairview Township. PAWC is requesting this area for its territory extension. The portion of Fairview Township being requested was approved by the PUC under Docket No. A-212285 under the acquisition of Red Land Water Company for water only¹. Furthermore, PAWC does have the territory adjunct to this territory request due to its acquisition of Fairview Borough Wastewater system². The map showing both these areas are attached as Attachment A-1. (Please note that the previous exhibit numbers have been blacked out for ease of reference).
