Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

We represent Respondent PECO Energy Company (“PECO”) in the above-referenced matter. We write with respect to Complainants Agnes and Steve Atuahene’s (“Complainants”) Motion for Reconsideration or in the Alternative for Leave to File Exceptions and their Petition to Strike the Final Order of the Commission. Complainants allege that they never received ALJ Angela Jones’ Initial Decision dated November 3, 2020, and that the Public Utility Commission’s (“PUC”) Final Order dated January 15, 2021 should be stricken. Complainants are arguing that ALJ Jones’ office sent the Initial Decision to the wrong email address and did not mail a hard copy (and thus they never received it and were not able to file exceptions).

Based on the information we have, PECO does not know whether the Initial Decision was sent to the wrong email address or if ALJ Jones’ office mailed a hard copy of the Initial Decision to Complainants. Complainants allege that they never received the Initial Decision via email or mail. PECO does not know if Complainants’ allegations are true. However, if Complainants did not receive the Initial Decision, PECO has no objection to Complainants being permitted to file exceptions to the Initial Decision, to which PECO would respond accordingly.¹

¹ It is worth noting for the Commission that Complainants are notorious abusers of the system, and were prohibited by ALJ Cynthia Williams Fordham in a March 27, 2014 decision from filing any further complaints until their balance was paid in full. *See Atuahene v. PECO Energy Company*, No. F-2014-2422759, 2014 WL 8629983, at *7–8 (Mar. 27, 2014).
