**JOINT STIPULATION FOR ADMISSION
OF TESTIMONY AND EXHIBITS INTO THE EVIDENTIARY RECORD**

TO THE HONORABLE MARY LONG:

This Joint Stipulation for Admission of Testimony and Exhibits into the Evidentiary Record ("Joint Stipulation") is entered into by Pike County Light & Power Company ("Pike" or "Company"); the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement ("I&E"); the Office of Consumer Advocate ("OCA"); and the Office of Small Business Advocate ("OSBA") (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Joint Petitioners"), by their respective counsel, in connection with the above-captioned matter. The Joint Petitioners respectfully request that Administrative Law Judge Mary Long admit into the evidentiary record of this proceeding the previously distributed written testimony and exhibits prepared by Pike, I&E, OCA, and OSBA's witnesses as identified below. In support of this request, the Joint Petitioners aver and state as follows:

1. On October 26, 2020, Pike County Light & Power Company (PCLP), filed Supplement No. 110 to Tariff Gas - Pa. P.U.C. No. 6 to become effective December 28, 2020, and docketed at R-2020-3022134 (Gas Filing). Tariff 6 contains proposed changes in rates, rules, and regulations calculated to produce \$262,000 (16%) in additional annual revenues.
2. Included with the initial filing on October 26, 2020, Pike provided the Direct Testimony and Exhibits as described below.

3. The proceeding was assigned to Administrative Law Judge Mary Long ("ALJ Long") for hearings and issuance of a Recommended Decision.

4. A prehearing conference was held on January 11, 2021, at which time a litigation schedule was established.

5. On February 2, 2021, I&E, OCA, and OSBA served their respective Direct Testimony and Exhibits as described below.

6. On February 22, 2021, Pike, OCA, and OSBA served their respective Rebuttal Testimony and Exhibits as described below.

7. On March 4, 2021, I&E, OCA, and OSBA served their respective Surrebuttal Testimony and Exhibits as described below.

8. Following the service of Joint Petitioners Surrebuttal Testimony, negotiations took place among the parties seeking to achieve a full settlement of the proceeding.

9. On March 5, 2021, Pike informed Judge Long that the parties had reached a settlement in principle and were working out a few details to finalize the settlement terms. The parties also agreed to mutually waive cross examination in this matter. At that time the parties requested that they submit the joint petition for settlement with statements in support by the previously assigned deadline of April 9, 2021. As a result of the settlement in principle, Judge Long further suspended the litigation schedule and canceled the evidentiary hearings scheduled for March 9-12, 2021 by the cancellation notices issued on March 8, 2021.

10. In support of the Settlement, each Joint Petitioner will submit, as an appendix to the Joint Petition, individual Statements in Support of the Settlement. If Administrative Law Judge Long and the Commission approve the terms and conditions set forth in the Joint Petition

without modification, this matter will be deemed to be fully resolved and no hearings will be held in connection with the Pike's gas rate case.

11. In order to further support the Settlement, the Joint Petitioners hereby stipulate to the admission of the following into the evidentiary record:
