Good afternoon Ms. Kailey:

As Ms. Fiske has requested her second continuance in this matter where she has stated that her attorney is not available, I would prefer to hear from her attorney to have the reason for his unavailability. In this regard, PGW is opposed to the request for a continuance without more information.

Further, in a previous communication Ms. Fiske indicated that she wanted to discuss the resolution of this matter with PGW. If she has counsel, it would be appropriate for PGW to speak with her counsel. PGW does not have any contact information with Ms. Fiske's attorney in order to make this happen.

The PGW business people have informed me that Ms. Fiske is entitled to a payment arrangement and perhaps even special programs based upon the most recent income information that PGW has. This income information needs to be updated and verified.

If Ms. Fiske would like to speak with a PGW representative about resolution of this matter rather than proceed with counsel, I can make that happen. PGW maintains that Ms. Fiske's PGW bills are correct as rendered but would like to provide her with a payment arrangement under the income criteria.

Thank you for your guidance. I really don't understand the procedures of the PUC hearings, which is why I need a lawyer. I would like to request a continuance to April when I understand my attorney, Mr. Morris, who was the lawyer at my PUC hearing a few years ago, would be available.

Since he was the attorney at the original case, he would understand the background and would not charge for reviewing documents.

The present case rests upon my missing the payment by a day and having the PGW say we go back to the original sum.

The original sum was accrued by my former landlord lying to his tenants that utilities were included in the rent. I have whittled off most of the original debt of \$6,000 to about \$1,000. Please inform me of the next step.

I would appreciate having this continued to April so my lawyer can participate.
