On March 23, 2021, PECO Energy Company filed a Petition for Expedited Approval to Establish a COVID-19 Emergency Grant Program for Low-Income Customers at Docket Number M-2015-2507139. The \$3.7 million in funding for the proposed grant program would come from PECO's unspent Low Income Usage Reduction Program (LIURP) funds from 2020, which were unspent due to the COVID-19 pandemic. In lieu of a formal Answer to PECO's Petition, the Tenant Union Representative Network (TURN) files this letter to notify the Public Utility Commission that TURN does not oppose PECO's proposal.
