Enclosed, please find F&P's executed "EGS" License Application to act as an intermediary as a Consultant, Broker, or Marketer, not taking title to electric energy.

Please note Attachment 7A contains a photocopy of the Letter of Credit issued by First Community Bank on December 24, 2020. The original Letter of Credit was submitted with the Petition of F&P Holdings, LP for Reconsideration filed on December 31, 2020 at Docket No. A-2012-2330700.

Two items have been noted "Privileged and Confidential" and included with the original application. These items are not included with the e-filed application, nor are they included with copies sent in accordance with the Certificate of Service (Attachment 6A of the application). The first item is F&P's tax returns for years 2018 and 2019. The second item is the Tax Certification Statement. F&P is a Limited Partnership and, therefore, financial information is not published nor made available to the general public or our competitors. The Tax Statement contains a personal Social Security number and is also considered confidential.

Additionally, it is our understanding that testing the EDI system will not be required as F&P will not be transmitting billing information with and EDCs.

We recognize our failure to adequately receive and act upon previous electronic notifications that our license was coming up for renewal. To prevent this from happening in the future, we have added my name as a second point of contact, as well as requesting that the email address of Operations@TandFexploration.com be used for future notices. The inbox of this email address is handled by our team of Agent Support Staff and provides us the necessary redundancy to make sure no notices go unhandled.

- Net Metering Reports: Applicant shall be responsible to report any Net Metering per the Standards on http://www.puc.pa.gov/consumer_info/electricity/alternative_energy.aspx. Scroll down to the Net Metering Standards Section.
- Applicant shall report to the Commission the percentages of total electricity supplied by each fuel source on an annual basis per 52 Pa. Code § 54.39(d).
- Applicant will be required to meet periodic reporting requirements as may be issued by the Commission to fulfill the Commission's duty under Chapter 28 pertaining to reliability and to inform the Governor and Legislature of the progress of the transition to a fully competitive electric market.



SERVICE AGREEMENT

THIS SERVICES AGREEMENT is effective as of this 1st day of September, 2010 ("Effective Date"), by and between T&F Exploration, L.P., a Pennsylvania limited partnership ("T&F") and F&P Holdings, L.P., a Pennsylvania limited partnership ("F&P").

Whereas, F&P is engaged in the marketing and sale of electricity service contracts and from time to time, utilizes the business resources of T&F and the parties desire to enter into this Agreement, so as to define their respective obligations between them.

Now, therefore, the parties hereto, intending to be legally bound hereby, agree as follows:


1. **Services.** T&F shall provide or otherwise make available to F&P, the following services: provide general office support, (on an as needed, as available basis) in T&F's Pittsburgh, PA office, and in its Buckhannon, WV offices. This includes making available F&P's existing office and clerical staff to perform general office support, contract administration, account reconciliation, billing services, as well as any other services, as agreed.
2. **Term.** The initial term of this Agreement is for twelve (12) months from the Effective Date, expiring on August 31, 2011. After the initial term, this Agreement shall automatically renew for successive one (1) year periods, unless either party provides not less than thirty (30) days prior written notice of termination, which must be sent not less than thirty days (30) days prior to the effective date of renewal, which is September 1, of each year.
3. **Compensation.** Commencing on September 1, 2010 and continuing for the remainder of the term of this Agreement, F&P shall pay to T&F, in advance on or before the first (1st) day of each month a monthly service fee in the amount of \$ 2500.00 per month ("Monthly Service Fee"). The Monthly Service Fee represents the costs of T&F to render to F&P the services outlined in Section 1. The Monthly Service Fee shall be reviewed annually and may be adjusted or modified, only with a signed written agreement of T&F and F&P.
4. **Proprietary Information.** Each party hereto hereby acknowledges and agrees that each has expended considerable time and effort in developing substantial confidential information applicable to its respective business including customer lists ("Proprietary Information"), and that each party considers its respective Proprietary Information to be confidential and to contain trade secrets and other information and material critically important to its business and existence. Each the T&F and F&P agrees, both during the

term of this Agreement and afterwards, not to use or misappropriate the Proprietary Information of the other party hereto for its own benefit or for the benefit of any third party unless the proposed use has been expressly agreed to in writing by the other party hereto.

5. **Independent Contractor.** T&F is an independent contractor of F&P hereunder, and neither the T&F, nor F&P shall be deemed to be a partner, joint venturer, agent employee/employer of the other. T&F shall only devote such amount of its staff and resources as is reasonably required to perform services as required hereunder, it being understood that F&P is only interested in the results of such services. T&F shall not have authority, express or implied, to commit F&P in any way to perform in any manner, or to pay money for services or materials or otherwise. T&F shall have sole control over the manner and means used to perform services hereunder, consistent with its status as an independent contractor upon the terms hereof.
6. **Entire Agreement.** This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties regarding the subject matter hereof and integrates all prior discussions and statements between them relative to the subject matter hereof.
7. **Modifications.** No modification, amendment, revocation or waiver of this Agreement shall be binding unless the same is made in writing and executed by all parties hereto.
8. **Governing Law.** This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with and governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania without regard for its conflicts of laws provisions.


